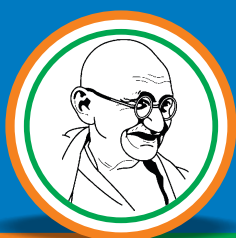

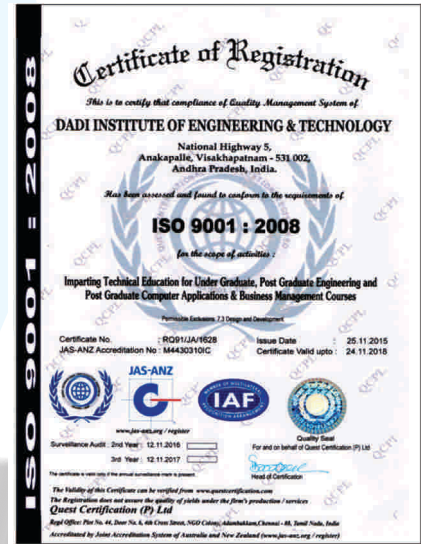

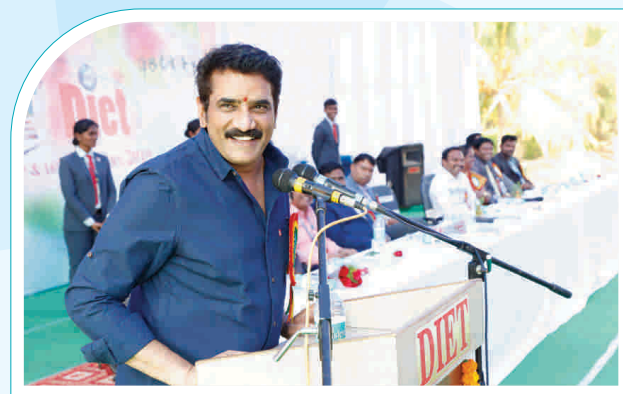

Design and implementation of an off grid 2kwp pv system with mppt for illumination of LED lights

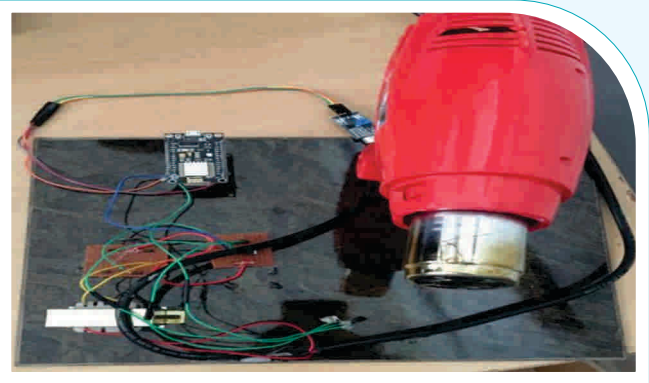
