JNTUK MBA Regulation-Wise Distribution and Weight age of Marks

R16/R13 Regulations (Applicable for the batches admitted from 2013-14)

- 1) The performance of a student in each semester shall be evaluated subject—wise with a maximum of **100 marks for theory** subject and **100 marks for practical** subject.
- 2) The viva-voce examination of the **project report** shall be conducted by board consisting of external examiner, the HOD and the supervisor. The candidate should have to secure **Grade A(Excellent)/ Grade B(Good)/ Grade C(Satisfactory)** in project viva-voce. If the Candidate fails to secure Grade A/ Grade B/ Grade C in Viva-voce, the candidate will retake the examination after three months. If he fails to get Grade A/ Grade B/ Grade C at the second viva-voce examination, he will not be eligible for the award of degree, unless the candidate is asked to revise and resubmit. If the candidate fails to secure Grade A/ Grade B/ Grade C again, the project shall be summarily rejected.
- 3) For theory subjects the distribution shall be **40 marks for Internal Evaluation** and **60 marks for the End Examinations.**
- 4) The Internal marks 40 shall be awarded based on internal examination. Two internal examinations of 40 marks each will be conducted in semester and taking average for awarding the final internal marks.

The weightage of Internal marks for 40 consists of **Descriptive – 20, Mini Report – 10, Presentation -10.** 

The descriptive examination is for 120 minutes duration conducted for 20 marks and the question paper shall contain 4 questions and all questions need to be answered.

- 5) As the syllabus is framed for 5 units, the Test-1 is conducted in first  $2\frac{1}{2}$  units and Test-2 in the remaining  $2\frac{1}{2}$  units of each subject in a semester.
- 6) For practical subject(only Sem I), 60 marks shall be awarded based on the performance in endsemester examination, 40 marks shall be awarded based on the day-day performance as internal marks.
- 7) The End Semester Examination is conducted covering the topics of all Units for 60 marks.
- 8) For the **Mini Project and Seminar on Mini Project** (**Sem II only**), Each student has to be evaluated based on the presentation of any latest topic with report of minimum of 50 pages and a ppt of min 20 slides. The student shall collect the information on a specialized topic and prepare a report, showing his understanding over the topic, and submit to the department, which shall be evaluated by the Departmental committee consisting of Head of the department, seminar supervisor and a senior faculty member. The Mini Project report and Seminar on Mini Project shall be evaluated for 50 marks each. There shall be no external examination for Mini Project and Seminar on Mini Project.
- 9) Evaluation of Project Works: A Project Review Committee (PRC) of the college is to be constituted with Principal/Director as chairperson, heads of the departments, which are offering PG courses, and two other Senior faculty members of the department offering MBA. Every Candidate shall work on projects approved by the PRC of the college.

A student has to undergo practical training for a period of 6 weeks in a corporate enterprise after the 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester/Summer Vacation.

Three copies of Project dissertation certified by the Project supervisor shall be submitted to the College. The project report shall be adjudicated by one examiner selected by the University. The college will submit 5 member panel who are eminent in the field of study.

## **Pass Marks Criteria**:

Minimum Pass Marks for Theory/Lab End Exam: 24 out of 60 (40%)

Minimum Pass Marks for Theory/Lab (Internal(40) + External(60)): 50 out of 100 (50%)

\* There is no minimum pass mark for Theory/Lab Internal.

Minimum Pass Marks for Mini Project and Seminar on Mini Project each: 25 (50%)
