

















Action Plan:

- Upon receiving the Feedback reports on the Curriculum of various academic regulations by stake holders including students, teachers, employers, alumni, a discussion was held with IQAC convener, HODs and all the Academic Committee Members of the Institute
- It was identified that the frequency of industrial visits need to improve to offer better knowledge in a practical way to the student community
- Faculty are informed to focus more on the research activities and management came forward to provide the necessary infrastructure for the same
- Committee suggested to encourage the students to execute projects in the respective courses to get more practical knowledge.
- Students have requested for more number of workshops in association with professional collaborations like APSSDC, NIT Warangal etc.,
- Students have requested for conduct of CRT sessions and training for competitive exams like GATE, PGECET etc.,
- Faculty members are suggested to work on development of curriculum through introduction of appropriate add-on courses to bridge the industry gaps in syllabus

Action Taken Report:

- APSSDC based workshops have been conducted for all students of B.Tech III year through several technologies like Revit Structures, IoT based workshops, Embedded Systems, Industrial Automation with PLCs etc.,
- Professional body events through IEEE, CSI, ISTE, IETE IEI etc., were made a regular part of the department activity calendar and the same has been complied by regular monitoring
- Add-on courses were planned for all branches including latest technologies like Python Programming, Total Station Survey, Design of power converters, MATLAB for signal processing, Programming using C etc.,
- CRT Sessions were conducted for III B.Tech. in two spells for all branches to compete for the campus placement drives
