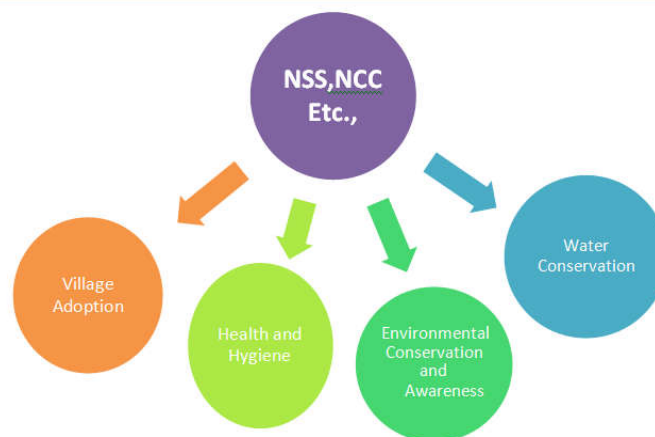


Fig. No. 1 : NSS Areas
