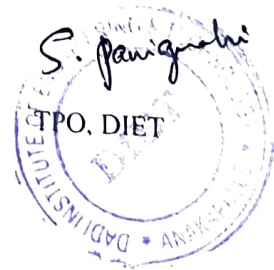

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING(MOU)

3rd-August-2016, Hyderabad

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and executed at Hyderabad on the 3rd-Aug-2016. This MOU signifies a statement of intent for collaboration between. **M/s. COIGN CONSULTANTS PVT. LTD (COIGN)** having corporate office address situated at 4F2, 5th Floor, Ballad Estates, Opp: ISO Junior College, Tarnaka, Secunderabad – 500017 represented by Mr. Anantha Prasanna K, the Director of the organization, R/o: Plot no:117, Lane No:6, Hastinapuram Central, Shirdi Sai Nagar Colony, Vaisalinagar PO, Hyderabad-500 079. M/s. COIGN consultants Pvt. Ltd., a leading software & technology training company for the purpose of enriching the technical education process and to jointly work for enhancing the quality of education imparted to students of B-Tech discipline herein after called the **FIRST PARTY**

AND

DADI INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY an Institution located Near ANAKAPALLI, VISAKHAPATNAM - 531002, which was established in 2006 represented by **Mr. K Venugopal Rao**, Principal, DIET herein after called as the **SECOND PARTY**.

Terms & Conditions:

1. Nature of Relationship

- a) This MOU is for collaboration between both parties, for mutual benefit, for many purposes to enhance the quality of the educational experience for students of the college.
- b) This MOU shall be valid for three years from the date of signing of MOU and each party shall be at full liberty to terminate the collaboration with a notice period of 1 month.
- c) Both parties shall take all reasonable steps to ensure successful completion of the collaboration and cooperate with each other in duly carrying out the obligation agreed upon.
- d) The second party shall provide all the necessary facilities such as infrastructure, Network and Internet Access required for education and training as training is conducted in the college.

2. Mutual obligation

- a) This Collaboration shall not be exclusive to both parties and shall not disallow each party from having similar collaboration with others. Except as expressly stated in this MOU, there shall be no obligation on any party to compensate the other in any manner to make any claim.
- b) Each party shall respect the others intellectual property (IP) and shall not use any trade name, trade mark, symbol or designation belonging to the other, without prior written approval. No party shall hold out as an agent or representative of the other or create any liability for the other.
- c) Both parties shall maintain confidentiality about any information, plans, discussions, strategies or any material which shall be deemed to be confidential and marked accordingly.
- d) Both the Parties should not interact with faculties provided by each other except for the purpose of the training program and should not hire or offer any other financial proposals to the aforesaid during the period of training program and for one year after completion of the training.

3. Limitations and Warranties

- a) Each party shall ensure that the other is not put to any liability for any actions of the one party.

- b) Each party represents that they have the full power and authority to enter into this MOU in general.

4. General

- a) Both parties will designate a representative from its side who will be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party.
- b) COIGN will provide the list of faculties who will be involved in the training program.
- c) COIGN will provide schedules for all the training programs and tests.
- d) COIGN will be submitting the reports for all the examinations on time to time basis.
- e) COIGN to submit student progress report on regular basis
- f) College will provide the Labs with Internet facility for the conduction of the examinations for the students in case of offline training program
- g) COIGN will be responsible for the smooth handling of the college properties like Projector, Mic, Sound systems and COIGN will be held responsible for repairing the same in case of any damage.
- h) College is responsible for the conduction of the interim examinations for the students as per schedule.
- i) College is responsible for taking and maintaining the attendance of the students for the training program.
- j) College has to provide lunch & transport facility to the faculty coming for the training program.
- k) Both parties shall not use the name of the other in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.

- l) Any dispute under this MOU will be settled in Hyderabad through arbitration, if necessary. In witness where both the parties have set their hands to this MOU on the 3rd-August-2016 at Hyderabad.

5. PURPOSE/SCOPE OF THE COLLABORATION:

- **M/S. COIGN CONSULTANTS PVT. LTD. i.e. First Party** shall conduct a Pre-Training Assessment Test and based on the results of the Assessment Test the students will be selected into 4 batches.
- **M/S. COIGN CONSULTANTS PVT. LTD. i.e. First Party** shall conduct 72 hours “**Campus Recruitment Training**” for 4 batches starting from 3rd year for the students in our college.
- **M/S. COIGN CONSULTANTS PVT. LTD. i.e. First Party** will conduct regular assessments at the end of each module during the training program.

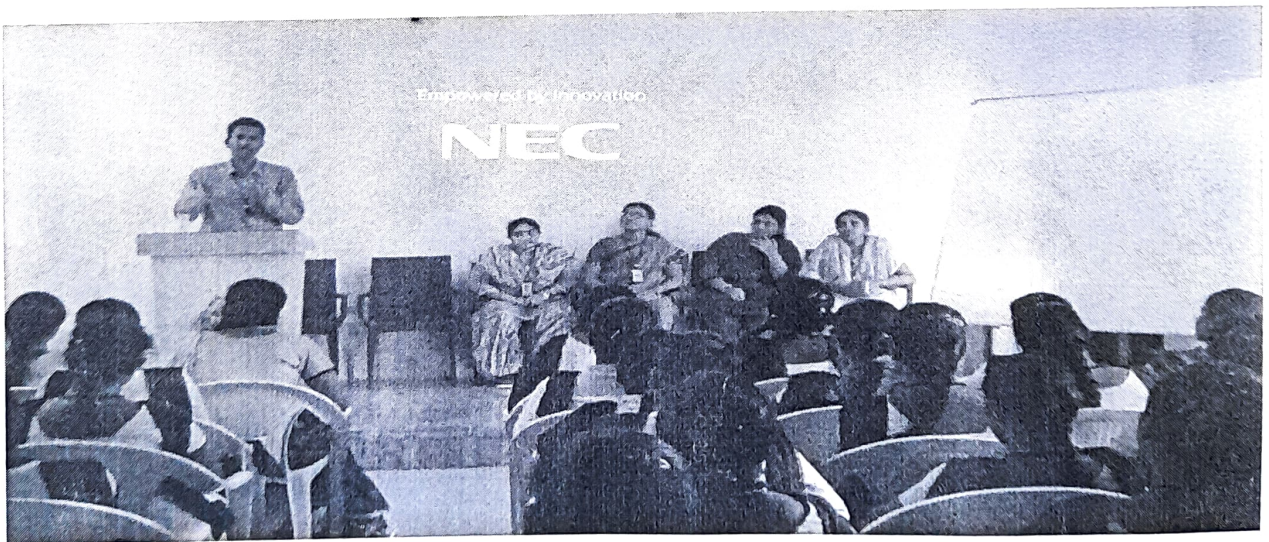

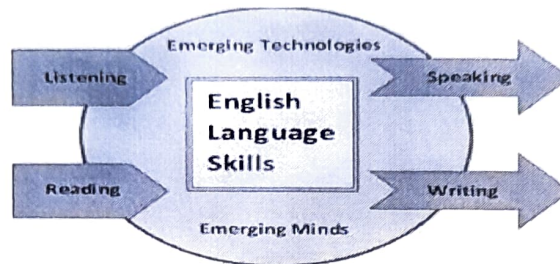

REPORT ON LANGUAGE SKILL DEVELOPMENT

The language skill development program plays an important role in the language learning process.

The focus is on the analysis and evaluation of receptive & productive skills based on various task-based/machine-based activities. It also focused on the development of target and scenario-based communication processes using correct English for language learning purposes. It focuses on the development of students' language & communication skills, critical thinking, and problem solving skills through the



understanding of 4 pillars of English Language viz. Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing.

Listening Skills

Listening is a receptive language skill which learners usually find the most difficult. This often is because they feel under unnecessary pressure to understand every word. The listener has to get oriented to the listening portion and be **all ears**. The listener is also required to be attentive. Anticipation is a skill to be nurtured in Listening.

In due course of listening, be in a lookout for the sign post words and one should be able to concentrate on understanding the message thoroughly. Listening Skills is enhanced by focusing on making the students listen to the sounds and help them with the right pronunciation of words.

In our Language Lab:



We progress from Attention to Accuracy through Situational Conversations/Role Play/Development of Argumentative Skills (using BEC audio in the Labs) and then the assessment is carried out.

SPEAKING

Language is a tool for communication. We communicate with others, to express our ideas, and to know others' ideas as well. We must take into account that the level of language input (listening) must be higher than the level of language production. In primary schools, elocution and recitation are main sources to master the sounds, rhythms, and intonation of the English language through simple reproduction. Understanding of para-linguistic attributes such as voice quality, volume and tone, voice modulation, articulation, pronunciation etc helps to better this skill.

What we do?

We initiate with make a presentation on self-followed by the basics of Public speaking; Etiquette while following correct voice modulation and acceptable Paralinguistic features. As we gear up for our further sessions, we assess the ability of being able to use acquired Speaking Skills using Extempore- Continuous Evaluation tool. Finally, through self- reflection activity, they will be able to make a comparison in one's evolution in terms of one's communication ability in a semester

Reading is a learning skill. It helps you improve all parts of the English language – vocabulary, spelling, grammar, and writing. It helps to develop language intuition in the corrected form. Then the brain imitates them, producing similar sentences to express the desired meaning. Using skimming or scanning technique to read quickly is highly effective. While reading underlining of key words is necessary. Reading Skills help the students grasp the content and draw conclusions. The students should also make it a point to familiarize themselves with the jargons and new words by making reading a habit be

it reading newspapers, articles, books, magazines etc

What we do and assess in labs?

We expose them to the different techniques of reading and we take them through the practicesession through mind map. Then we assess the ability of Reading Comprehension using standard BEC Reading Comprehension using Continuous Evaluation tool.

WRITING

Writing provides a learner with physical evidence of his achievements and he can measure his improvement. It helps to consolidate their grasp of vocabulary and structure, and complements the other language skills. It helps to understand the text and write compositions. It can foster the learner's ability to summarize and to use the language freely. To write flawless language one should excel in the Writing Skills with the help of various methods. Importance should be given to composition and creative writing. One should also focus on coherence when it comes to writing a language.

In these sessions, we help them to identify and apply critical thinking skills in writing. Assessment session helps them to apply language & reflective skills to create a write up for given iconic images.

Teaching of English language while ensuring focus on all these four skills provides a platform for the learners to hone their proficiency in this language well.

Components in the language lab:

- Teacher has a computer with Clarity for conducting language exercises
- Teacher and students wear headsets that block outside sounds and disturbances
- Students have a media player/recorder for listening to audio and recording speech
- Teacher and student positions are connected via LAN (local area network), in some cases also via separate audio cabin.

Report on Awareness session on E-Learning

I am sure you have frequently encountered the words like, e-government, e-health, e-shopping, e-business, e-commerce, e-books, e-libraries, e-learning and so on. Almost everything today has gone electronic, while a few years ago World Wide Web was considered a Privilege, today it is a necessity. Everyone can use and learn from electronic devices. ICT today has the power to transform Education. The new millennium heralds exciting opportunities to diversify the ways in which education is offered. A greater flexibility is provided through online access to learning – when, where and how to do it? Today anyone can obtain education anywhere, anytime through online education. Thus, breaking the shackles of traditional classroom and adapting to new and electronic learning Technologies empowers all learners irrespective of their diversities. This development in ICT has resulted in a learning environment called e-learning.

E-learning - CONCEPT AND CHARACTERISTICS

What is e-Learning?

E-learning is essentially imparting education through *computer and network enabled* digital technologies which include among other things, *internet, intranet, computer, satellite TV, CDROM, audio and video resources.*

The term e-learning was first used in the professional environment in the year 1999 at CBT Seminar at Los Angeles. Therefore e-learning could be broadly defined as use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) to enhance and support learning. This could range from teachers and students using e-mail for communication to entirely online courses. This term is used synonymously with virtual learning, online learning, computer based learning, web based learning, and networked learning.

E-learning is defined by many people, in many ways, since the term e-learning is used inconsistently, in order to gain a clear understanding of what e-learning is, here are a few definitions of e-learning.

The letter "e" in e-learning stands for the word "electronic", e-learning would incorporate all educational activities that are carried out by individuals or groups working online or offline via networked or standalone computers and other electronic devices.

- Brandon Hall defines E-learning as: "...instruction that is delivered electronically, in part or wholly via a Web browser, through the Internet or an intranet, or through multimedia platforms such as CD-ROM or DVD."

- Rosenberg: "E-learning refers to the use of Internet technologies to deliver a broad array of solutions that enhance knowledge and performance." Rosenberg claims that e-learning is based on three fundamental criteria:

- E-learning is networked, instant updating, storage and retrieval, distribution and sharing of information is therefore possible.
- E-learning is delivered to the end-user via a computer using standard internet technologies.

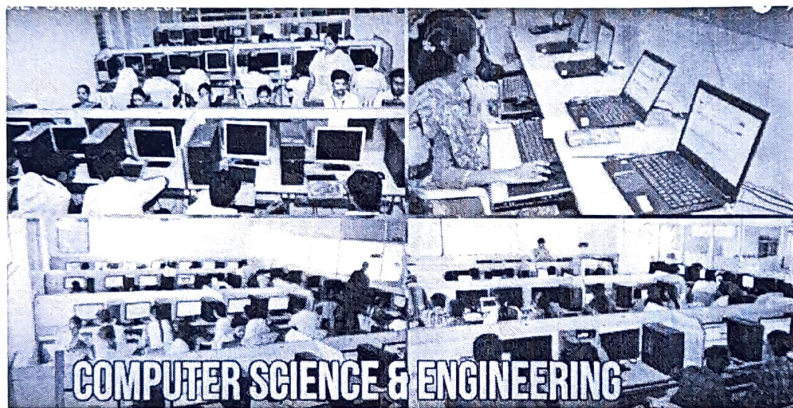
- E-learning focuses on the broadest view of learning: Learning solutions going beyond the traditional paradigms of training.
- E-learning involves the use of a computer or electronic device (e.g. a mobile phone) in some way to provide training, educational or learning material.
- Defines e-learning as: Web-based training (WBT), also known as e-learning and on-line learning, is training that resides on a server or host computer that is connected to the World Wide Web.
- "E-learning refers to educational processes that utilise information and communications technology to mediate synchronous as well as asynchronous learning and teaching activities"
- "E-learning is the use of new multimedia technologies and the Internet to improve the quality of learning by facilitating access to resources and services, as well as remote exchange and collaboration."
- "E-learning is the delivery of education (all activities relevant to instructing, teaching, and learning) through various electronic media"

Thus, E-Learning is the use of technology to enable people to learn anytime and anywhere. E-learning can include training, the delivery of just-in-time information and guidance from experts. E-learning could also be considered distance education in an evolved form, which has taken advantages of all the emerging technologies for enhancing learning experiences of every learner. In that sense e-learning could be considered as a new generation of distance education.

Characteristics of E- learning

- **E-learning is Learner-Centric Learning:** The learner centric e-learning model makes an array of resources available to the learner, who is free to choose when, where and how to learn.
- **E-learning for lifelong learning:** With increasing access to technologies and its ever increasing sophistication this approach to learning facilitates lifelong learning among various stake holders.
- **E-learning is Flexible Learning:** E-learning has historically been linked with distance education and flexible learning. In distance education, various technologies can be used to link learners, instructors and resources that are removed in time or space. The hallmark of flexible learning, as its name suggests, is its adaptability to learners' needs and circumstances.

- **E-learning is Social:** E-learning seeks to foster collaboration and peers interaction. Various e-learning technologies facilitate various types of collaboration among learners and teachers.
- **E-learning Involves Learning Objects:** E-learning uses reusable learning objects. This RLO permits one to create e-learning course with ease.
- **E-learning is Personalized:** Usually e-learning system permits its users to personalize the learning by tailoring its offerings to their learning style, job requirements, career goals, current knowledge and personal preferences.
- **E-learning Involves Effective Communication:** The effectiveness of e-learning also depends on establishing two-way communication between teachers and learners, and among learners themselves. There are many standalone tools as well as learner management system integrated tools to foster interactive and collaborative engagement.



Impact of E-learning:

- Social interaction and connectedness through different digital and online platforms.
- Exploring more global e-resources including lecture series, e-book, online documents and journals.
- Increase IT skills in all the stakeholders related to teaching learning system.
- Flexible learning for all.
- Enhanced research collaboration with global institutes.
- Wide global conference, webinar, conclaves, meeting and discussion in digital platforms.
