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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is entered into this 25th day of JULY, 2018.

DADI INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY and COIGN CONSULTANTS, herewith enter into an agreement with respect to campus recruitment training for the students. That, **COIGN CONSULTANTS**, agreed and is willing to sign the terms and conditions pertaining to the training program of **DADI INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING and TECHNOLOGY**.

- A. That, **COIGN CONSULTANTS**, represented by **HEAD – Business Development, Mr. ANANTH PRASANNA K**, based at Visakhapatnam, has considerable experience in training. After having shown interest, **COIGN CONSULTANTS** has gone through the curriculum of the **DIET** and had submitted a proposal for campus recruitment training at latter's premises.
- B. That, **DADI INSTITUTE of ENGINEERING and TECHNOLOGY** represented by **PRINCIPAL, Dr. CH S NAGA PRASAD**, is an Engineering and Technology Educational Institution based at Anakapalle, Visakhapatnam catering to the educational needs of students from different branches of Engineering Studies, has gone through the proposal of the **COIGN CONSULTANTS**.
- C. After having formal discussions on the subject, both the parties have decided to enter into an agreement, which they are executing this agreement. That, the terms and conditions with respect to the agreement are drafted after mutual consent and duly signed by the representatives.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT

OBJECTIVES:

- I. Training to be provided by experienced and efficient trainers, which will be useful for the students of DIET (DADI INSTITUTE of ENGINEERING and TECHNOLOGY) for the purpose of career placements' related selection procedure.
- II. Trainers to take the initiative for the active participation of students, which the sessions to be productive and the training to be flexible to reach the standards of basic level of understanding.
- III. Campus Recruitment Training, as the name suggests, should be relevant to the present employability skills of the job market, which will be useful to the final year students of B.Tech, at the time of companies' selection process.
- IV. After the completion of the training program, trainers to evaluate the program outcome, by the way of conducting written tests, mock interviews and the selection process relevant to the respective branch of B.Tech.

CURRICULUM/ DURATION/DISCIPLINE:

- V. That, COIGN CONSULTANTS agrees to impart training based on the curriculum discussed and given by DIET, also relevant content if any, suitable for the training program will be added at any stage of the training process with mutual consent the parties.
- VI. That, the strength of the students in a section will be 60 and each section will be allocated with one trainer. In any case, to increase the strength of a section/class room, the COIGN CONSULTANTS will have to go forward only with consultation of Department of Training and Placements of the DIET.

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- VII. The COIGN CONSULTANTS will allocate trainers according to the requirement: - 120 hours per section of students, which is spread across 40 days duration. It means that, 40 days * 3 hours/day/section (60 students) = 120 hours of training duration, which is exclusive of Sundays, Public Holidays and Regional Holidays if any, accordingly.
- VIII. Allocation of the trainers, monitoring their punctuality and attendance is the primary and sole responsibility of the COIGN CONSULTANTS. In case of the absence of a trainer, the COIGN CONSULTANTS will arrange for a substitute to facilitate the continuity of the training program.
- IX. That, the COIGN CONSULTANTS will conduct a review at every stage of the training program. There are four stages at which reviews are to be conducted: a) 10th Day, b) 20th Day c) 30th Day and 4) 40th Day.
- X. The COIGN CONSULTANTS will conduct PRE-ASSESSMENT TEST, even before the commencement of the program to assess the standard and understanding level of the students of a particular branch of B.Tech, submit the same to the DIET and then proceed with the training process.
- XI. The COIGN CONSULTANTS will conduct a POST-ASSESSMENT TEST, after the completion of training program, at the end of 40th day, B.Tech-branch wise and submit the same to the Department of Training and Placements of the DIET.
- XII. That, the COIGN CONSULTANTS will conduct written tests and mock interviews on completion of the training program to assess the employability skills of the students. This would be a measure and evaluation of the training program conducted.
- XIII. The COIGN CONSULTANTS will give DEMO SESSIONS to the Department of Training and Placements / Management of the DIET even before the commencement of the training program, based on the inputs and assessments of the DIET will incorporate necessary changes and then continue with the training program.
- XIV. That, the right to evaluate/break the agreement at any and every stage and decision making right on continuity of the training program vests/lies with the DIET only.

PAYMENT CONDITIONS:

- XV. The DIET shall pay according to the intervals given below to the COIGN CONSULTANTS.
- 25% of the mutually agreed fee at the time of commencement of the training program
 - 25% of the mutually agreed fee after 50% of completion of the training program
 - 25% of the mutually agreed fee after 75% of completion of the training program
 - 25% of the mutually agreed fee after 100% of completion of the training program
- XVI. That, the DIET shall pay only through online mode or by account cheque at every interval. No cash payments requests will be entertained at any stage of payment.
- XVII. The DIET, if evaluates at any stage and judges that the training program is not as per the required standards and breaks the agreement then the fee due till that particular day of breach of agreement, whatever the COIGN CONSULTANTS is entitled to will be calculated and paid by the DIET.

PROGRAM OUTCOME/EXPECTATIONS:

- XVIII. The COIGN CONSULTANTS, will support the students at the time of placement drives [On -campus, Off-campus, Pool-campus] in the form of conducting review / refresher session in advance.
- DIET will inform 2-4 days in advance and the COIGN CONSULTANTS will support for the Placement drives, for at least 5 (Five) companies.
- XIX. That, the COIGN CONSULTANTS will ensure, training program conversion ratio will be above 75%, in terms of number of students successful in the selection process of the companies which they attend to after completion of training program.

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XX. The COIGN CONSULTANTS will strike a balance between Good, Average and Below Average students; impart training in such a way that there is a uniformity of skill set in maximum number of students.

TRANSPORT/LOGISTICS/ FACILITIES:

- XXI. The COIGN CONSULTANTS will have to take care of the transport facilities for their trainers. DIET will not provide for any pick and drop facility whatsoever for the purpose of training.
- XXII. DIET will not provide for accommodation and logistics, short stay or whatsoever to the trainers, for the purpose of training.
- XXIII. Trainees will have to arrange for their lunch/snacks expenses, which there is a facility of cafeteria available at the premises of the DIET.

FEEDBACK MANAGEMENT:


- XXIV. The COIGN CONSULTANTS will periodically take feedbacks from the trainers and students [branch-wise], submit the student feedback report to the Department of Training and Placements of the DIET at every stage of the training program (end of every 10 days) and after the completion of training program, for evaluation of the DIET.
- XXV. The DIET will take feedbacks at every stage, from the students (branch-wise) and evaluate the program outcome at the end of the training program.
- XXVI. Feedbacks will be crucial, will be considered at every stage and further will be the basis for continuity of the program. Final feedback at the end of the program will be evaluated and the same will be communicated to the COIGN CONSULTANTS by the DIET.

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

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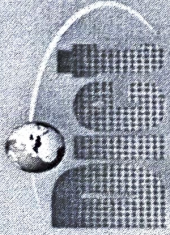

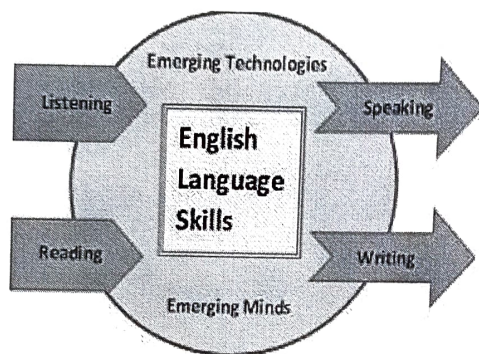

The language laboratory plays an important role in the language learning process. The focus is on the analysis and evaluation of receptive & productive skills based on various task-based/machine-based activities. It also focused on the development of target and scenario-based communication processes using correct English for language learning purposes. It focuses on the development of students' language & communication skills, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills through the understanding of 4 pillars of English Language viz. Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing.



Listening Skills

Listening is a receptive language skill which learners usually find the most difficult. This often is because they feel under unnecessary pressure to understand every word. The listener has to get oriented to the listening portion and **be all ears**. The listener is also required to be attentive. Anticipation is a skill to be nurtured in Listening.

In due course of listening, be in a lookout for the sign post words and one should be able to concentrate on understanding the message thoroughly. Listening Skills is enhanced by focusing on making the students listen to the sounds and help them with the right pronunciation of words.

In our Language Lab:



We progress from Attention to Accuracy through Situational Conversations/Role Play/Development of Argumentative Skills (using BEC audio in the Labs) and then the assessment is carried out.

Speaking

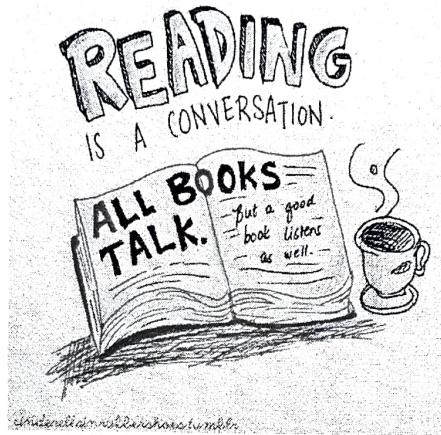
Language is a tool for communication. We communicate with others, to express our ideas, and to know others' ideas as well. We must take into account that the level of language input (listening) must be higher than the level of language production. In primary schools, elocution and recitation are main sources to master the sounds, rhythms, and intonation of the English language through simple reproduction. Understanding of para-linguistic attributes such as voice quality, volume and tone, voice modulation, articulation, pronunciation etc helps to better this skill.



What we do?

We initiate with make a presentation on self-followed by the basics of public speaking; Etiquette while following correct voice modulation and acceptable Paralinguistic features. As we gear up for our further sessions, we assess the ability of being able to use acquired Speaking Skills using Extempore- Continuous Evaluation tool. Finally, through self- reflection activity, they will be able to make a comparison in one's evolution in terms of one's communication ability in a semester

Reading



Reading is a learning skill. It helps you improve all parts of the English language – vocabulary, spelling, grammar, and writing. It helps to develop language intuition in the corrected form. Then the brain imitates them, producing similar sentences to express the desired meaning. Using skimming or scanning technique to read quickly is highly effective. While reading underlining of key words is necessary. Reading Skills help the students grasp the content and draw conclusions. The students should also make it a point to familiarize themselves with the jargons and new words by making reading a habit be it reading newspapers, articles, books, magazines etc.

What we do and assess in labs?

We expose them to the different techniques of reading and we take them through the practice session through mind map. Then we assess the ability of Reading Comprehension using standard BEC Reading Comprehension Using Continuous Evaluation tool.

Writing

Writing provides a learner with physical evidence of his achievements and he can measure his improvement. It helps to consolidate their grasp of vocabulary and structure, and complements the other language skills. It helps to understand the text and write compositions. It can foster the learner's ability to summarize and to use the

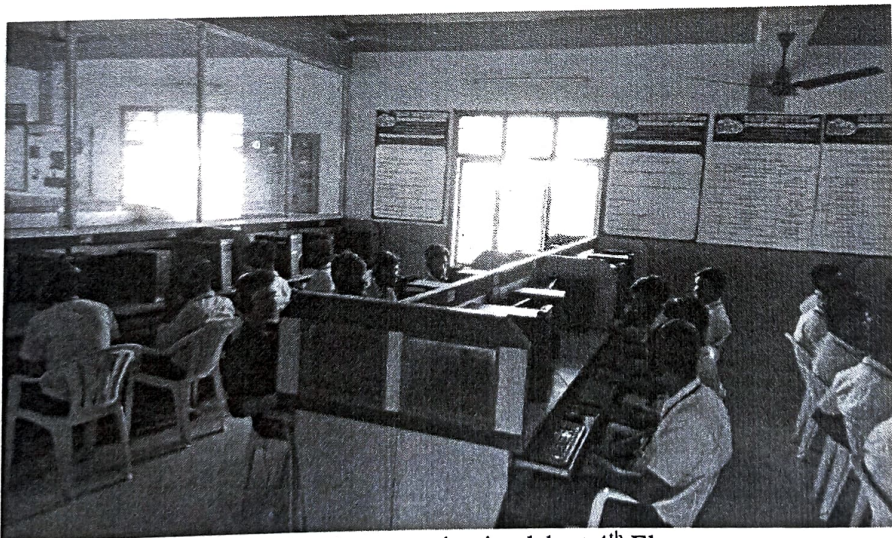
language freely. To write flawless language one should excel in the Writing Skills with the help of various methods. Importance should be given to composition and creative writing. One should also focus on coherence when it comes to writing a language.

In these sessions, we help them to identify and apply critical thinking skills in writing. Assessment session helps them to apply language & reflective skills to create a write up for given iconic images.

Teaching of English language while ensuring focus on all these four skills provides a platform for the learners to hone their proficiency in this language well.

Components in the language lab:

- Teacher has a computer with Clarity for conducting language exercises
- Teacher and students wear headsets that block outside sounds and disturbances
- Students have a media player/recorder for listening to audio and recording speech
- Teacher and student positions are connected via LAN (local area network), in some cases also via separate audio cabin.
