Participants receive sets of programming problems over 24 hours, starting at 0:00 UTC (5:30AM IST) on the competition date. All teams receive the same problems to solve and are expected to solve the problems without direct outside consultation. Teams don't need to tackle every problem, but the more they solve, the more points they score. Points are awarded based on how the problem was solved, the time it took, and its difficulty. Higher-grade IEEE members serve as judges and proctors for the competition.

The competition is free, but IEEE Student Membership is required to participate. Students - undergraduate and graduate - are welcome to register as IEEE Student Members and participants in IEEE Xtreme on the same day. The cost of IEEE Student Membership varies from country to country.



RULES:

- Each participant has to write the code for given problem, with MONITOR OFF.
- Participants whose code gets executed will be given higher preference.
- The second preference will be given to code with least number of errors.
- In case of tie in number of errors, TIME of SUBMISSION will be considered.

In this contest, the coders compete while also improving their overall algorithmic knowledge. The coding contest helps students and professionals to tackle a problem by reading the concepts one doesn't know, and also gain practical experience by coding the solution to the problem, thus improving their skills significantly. 
