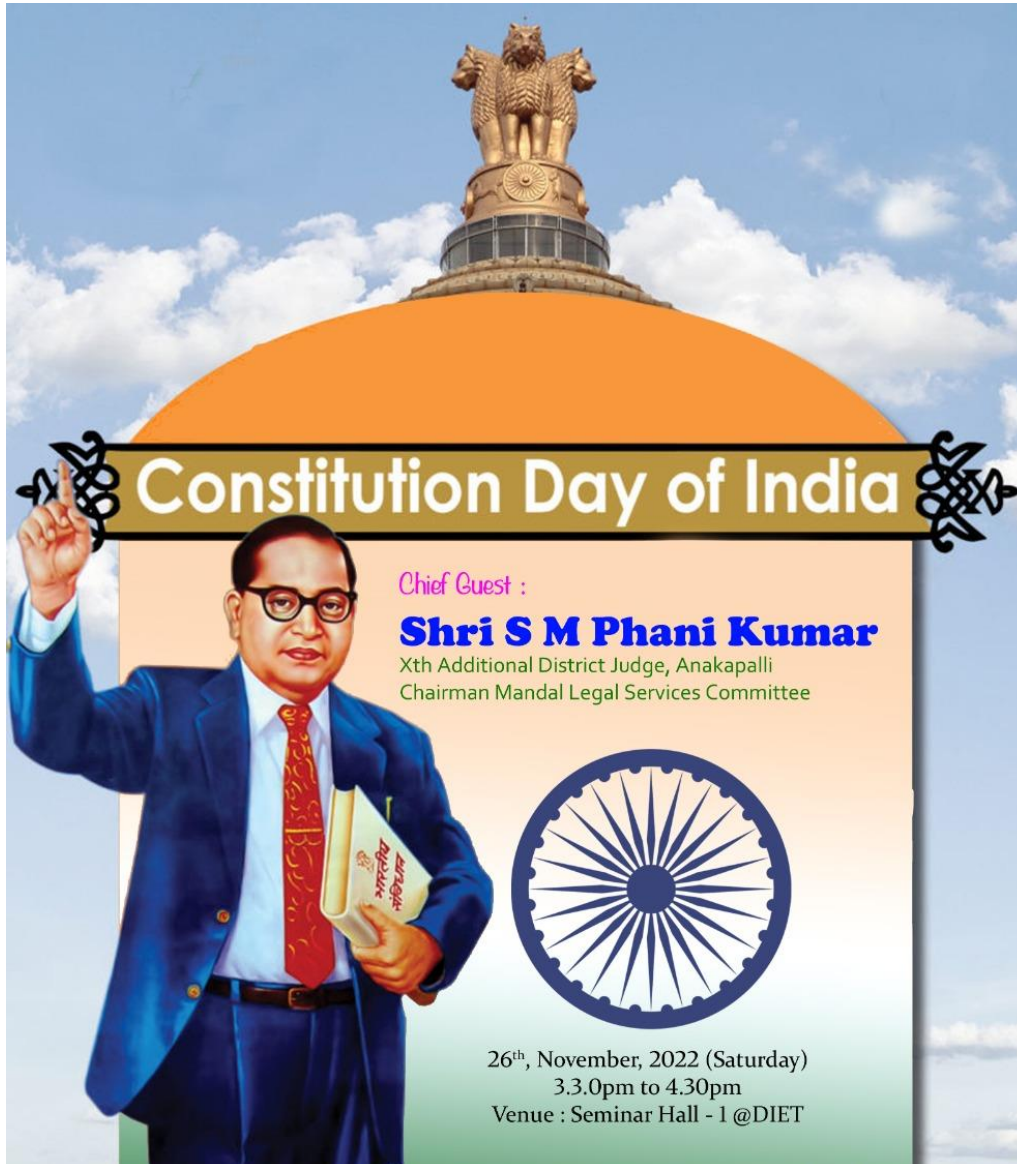

## Report on **Indian constitution Day.**

This day marks the **Indian constitution Day or National Law day.**

On January 26, 1950, the Indian Constitution became effective. Every year on November 26, India observes Constitution Day, also known as National Law Day, **to commemorate the day the Indian Constitution was adopted by the Constituent Assembly in 1949.**

**The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment** on 19th November 2015 notified the decision of Government of India to celebrate the 26th day of November every year as 'Constitution Day' to promote Constitution values among citizens.

Constitution Day also known as 'Samvidhan Divas', is celebrated in our country on 26th November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26th November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution of India, which came into effect from 26th January 1950.

The Government of India declared 26 November as Constitution Day on 19 November 2015 by a gazette notification. The Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi made the declaration on 11 October 2015 while laying the foundation stone of the B. R. Ambedkar's Statue of Equality memorial in Mumbai.<sup>[2]</sup> The year of 2021 was the 131st birth anniversary of Ambedkar, who had chaired the drafting committee of the Constituent Assembly and played a pivotal role in the drafting of the constitution.<sup>[1]</sup> Previously this day was celebrated as Law Day.<sup>[3]</sup> 26 November was chosen to spread the importance of the constitution and to spread thoughts and ideas of Ambedkar. PM Modi Speech On National Law Day 2021, 26 November, and also The President, Vice President and Lok Sabha Speaker also addressed the program.

Since 2015 was the 125th birth anniversary year of B. R. Ambedkar (14 April 1891 – 6 December 1956), who is known as the father of the Indian constitution, the government decided in May 2015 to celebrate this year "in a big way".<sup>[6][7][8]</sup> A special committee chaired by Prime Minister of India was announced for year-long celebrations. Various programmes will be held by various ministries and departments throughout the year to spread thoughts and ideas of Ambedkar.

Afterwards, **Sri S.M.Phani kumar Garu** made the Engineering students take pledge that they should follow socialism, secularism, Indian law and its penal codes and pay attention completely on their studies. In this programme, the Honorable Chairman Garu **Sri Dadi Ratnakar Garu**, Principal **Dr.Ch.Narasimham Garu** and NSS programme officer-in-charge

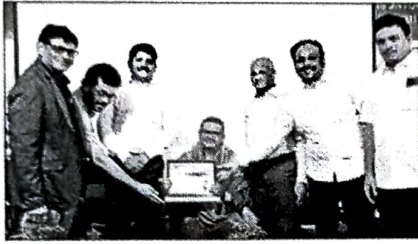
