**Minutes of Second Academic Council Meeting (ACM) through Blended Mode held on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2024**

1. The Principal of the institution (i.e., the Chairman) introduced the University officials and external members of ACM to the internal members.
2. The chairman has given PPT presentation of DR-23 Academic Regulations for B.Tech courses in an elaborated manner and compared with JNTU-GV R23 Academic Regulations and APSCHE Guidelines.
3. The members of ACM deliberated their views and made discussions at length and approved the DR-23 Academic Regulations for B.Tech courses as the regulations are in line with JNTU-GV R23 Academic Regulations and APSCHE Guidelines.
4. The members of ACM approved the DR-19 Academic Regulations for M.Tech and M.B.A courses of the institution as the regulations are in line with JNTU-GV R19 Academic Regulations.
5. The members of ACM discussed at length the evaluation process to consider for the result processing and suggested certain measures which have to be ratified in the results/evaluation Committee and place the same in the next ACM for necessary approval.
6. Meanwhile the results/evaluation committee may be permitted to declare the results of I B.Tech-First Semester (DR-23) duly following the suggestions given by the Academic Council Members.
7. The members of ACM suggested that the question paper setting is preferable from the senior faculty of the reputed government institutions or doctorates from the Deemed/Private Universities.
8. The members of ACM suggested that the paper correction is preferable from the senior faculty of the autonomous institutions or doctorates from Deemed/Private Universities.
9. The members of ACM suggested that the paper correction with internal faculty is not preferable for regular examinations. However, the senior faculty of the institution may be considered for paper correction for supplementary examinations.
10. The members of ACM suggested the Chairman to see that all external members to be present in ACMs through hybrid mode if not possible through offline.
