He then presented the syllabus of the all-civil Engineering subjects in I & II semesters for UG prepared by internal BOS members.

Agenda:

To approve the curriculum and syllabus of the II B.Tech., I & II Semester Civil Engineering course structure DR23.

Points Discussed:


1. Discussed about the proposed course structure draft copy and syllabus for II B.Tech year w.e.f. the year 2024-25 onwards.
2. Discussed about modifications to incorporate experiential and participatory learning in line with Outcome based education in UG Syllabus.
3. Discussed about the Subjects swapping from one semester to another semester.
4. Discussed to change Building Planning Drawing as main Subject with 3 credits instead of Skill Enhancement Course with 2 credits.
5. Discussed to retain Strength of materials I & II as per the R20 regulations instead of single Strength of Material subject in R23.
6. Discussed to remove Engineering Geology subject in II Semester, to introduce Building Planning Drawing as main subject with 3 credits.
7. Discussed to change Fluid Mechanics and Hydraulic Machines Lab from III Year I Semester to II Year I Semester to maintain the continuity of the subject Fluid Mechanics since it was kept as Subject in II Year I Semester.
8. Discussed to retain Survey Field work lab -I & II in two different semesters as per the R20 regulations instead of Single Survey Field Work lab (SFW-I & II Merged) in R23.
9. Discussed as proposal to main 2 subjects and one lab along with Project in IV-II Semester.
10. Discussed on any minor corrections / modifications / additions required in the framed course structure and syllabi.

Resolutions:

After fruitful discussions, relevant comments were incorporated appropriately in the Curriculum and Syllabi & the following points are resolved unanimously.

1. Discussed the proposed course structure draft copy to finalize the course structure and syllabus for B.Tech II year w.e.f. 2024-25 onwards.
2. No Alterations in Course Structure, it should be same for the entire state of Andhra Pradesh, Stated by Prof. GVR Srinivasa Rao, Vice Chancellor, JNTU Ananthapur.
3. Provision given to change Syllabus with 20% alteration along with proper justification.
4. Subject swapping possible with same credits only.
5. All the Autonomous Institutes can offer New Subjects for Professional Electives only.
6. Discussed about minor modifications in UG Syllabus to incorporate experiential and participatory learning in line with Outcome based education.
7. The Board authorized BOS Chairman for any minor corrections / modifications / additions required in the syllabi of II-I & II-II.
8. Swapping of subjects with same credits from one semester to another semester and modifications of syllabi should done with proper justification only.

Mr. M. RVSG Gupta, Chairman - BOS, thanked all the esteemed BOS members for their kind cooperation and the meeting came to an end.





Mr. M RVSG Gupta - BOS Chairman addressing the BOS members in the virtual meeting






BOS Chairman explanation about the changes in course structure along with syllabi.






Prof. Dr. B.V. Saradhi, Civil Engineering Dept., Andhra University giving his suggestions on the continuity of subjects while changing the syllabus.
