

Resources centers & special educators to support their habilitation & educational needs of learner's with severe or multiple disabilities.



Diet Literary and Cultural Club (**DLCC**) organized a webinar on "Multidisciplinary & Holistic Education" to discuss on transformative reforms under National Education Policy. Webinar is being conducted on 2nd August 2021.

Prof. Challa Narasimham, Principal, Dadi Institute of Engineering and Technology, **Dr. J.Babu, Professor**, Dadi Institute of Engineering and Technology spoke on various sub-themes covering Holistic and Multidisciplinary education.

Speaking on "Holistic and Multidisciplinary Education", **Prof. Challa Narasimham** said that the characteristic features of Indian education system such as value system, sustainable philosophy of life, respect for plurality and multidisciplinary and holistic education system

actually established India as Vishwaguru in the ancient times. Explaining various aspects of National Education Policy such as integration of humanities and arts with STEM subjects, multiple entry and exit, restructuring of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes, mainstreaming of vocational education, Academic Bank of Credit etc. he informed how all these recommendations have generated a renewed interest in holistic and multidisciplinary education and thereby put Bharat on the path to Vishwaguru, again.

Prof. J.Babu provided a deep insight on the topic "Building a knowledge society through Holistic and Multidisciplinary higher education".

Citing various initiatives of the Govt. since 2014 **Prof. CH.Prabhakar** observed that the holistic and multidisciplinary reforms in NEP 2020 are in sync with the Govt. approach to inculcate the culture of innovative, flexible and open curriculum. The way to evolve holistic and multidisciplinary education is to make education more experiential, interesting, integrated, inquiry-driven, discoverey-oreinted, learner-centered, discussion-based, flexible and enjoyable. Referring to what constitutes a good education in ancient times, he said such notion of knowledge of many arts including its modern application will place Bharatiya higher education in a different sphere to give us an edge in 21st century.

The talk by **Ms. P.Jagruthi** dealt with "Towards transforming Higher Education through Multidisciplinary and Holistic approach", one of the proposed objectives of National Education Policy. In her speech, she said that one of the important things about the policy is it requires an individual to learn how to learn. Besides, she dwelt in detail about establishment of one multidisciplinary institution in every district by 2030, allowing free subject combinations which are in line with the global demands. Further, the talk throws light on attaining the objectives of internatilization, reforms in teacher education, and regulatory reforms and considered these reforms as the right moves to meet the diverse global demands through multidisciplinary system.

Mrs.D.L.Mythri latter explained that it is not only the subject specific knowledge which matters but also as how the discourse need to be conducted also matters. In addition to espousing holistic and multidisciplinary education she also elaborated on ways to make education holistic and how to achieve the culture of multidisciplinary.

recorded/uploaded. Then click on "Let's Sing" or on the right click at bottom right → (in case of mobile devices)

- (iv) Align the face to the screen (At this stage the portal may ask for permission to record audio and video from the device being used).
- (v) Once the face is aligned, Press on "Record" The national anthem music will start playing after a countdown from 3 and the text of the national anthem (in hindi) will be visible for use of those recording a video.
- (vi) Once the video has been recorded, there will be an option to listen to the recording before uploading or Restart (this will initiate the process on the portal ab-initio). If the individual is satisfied with the playback of the recording, Press Upload to enable the portal to save the video.
- (vii) On successful uploading of the National Anthem, a 'Certificate of Participation' is automatically issued.

arief summary of Abdul kalam

Early life and career

the 11th president of India from 2002 to 2007. He was born and raised in Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu and studied physics and aerospace engineering. He spent the next four decades as a scientist and science administrator, mainly at the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and was intimately involved in India's civilian space program me and military missile. He thus came to be known as the Missile Man of India for his work on the development of ballistic missile and launch vehicle technology. He also played a pivotal organizational, technical, and political role in India's Pokhran-II nuclear tests in 1998, the first since the original nuclear test by India in 1974.

President role, Awards

Kalam was elected as the 11th president of India in 2002 with the support of both the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party and the then opposition Indian National Congress. Widely referred to as the "People's President", he returned to his civilian life of education, writing and public service after a single term. He was a recipient of several prestigious awards, including the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian honour.

Loss of Indian former president

While delivering a lecture at the Indian Institute of Management Shillong, Kalam collapsed and died from an apparent cardiac arrest on 27 July 2015, aged 83. Thousands, including national-level dignitaries, attended the funeral ceremony held in his hometown of Rameswaram, where he was buried with full state honors



Acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) is a chronic, potentially life-threatening condition caused by the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). By damaging your immune system, HIV interferes with your body's ability to fight infection and disease HIV causes AIDS and interferes with the body's ability to fight infections.

The virus can be transmitted through contact with infected blood, semen or vaginal fluids. Within a few weeks of HIV infection, flu-like symptoms such as fever, sore throat and fatigue can occur. Then the disease is usually asymptomatic until it progresses to AIDS. AIDS symptoms include weight loss, fever or night sweats, fatigue and recurrent infections. No cure exists for AIDS, but strict adherence to antiretroviral regimens (ARVs) can dramatically slow the disease's progress as well as prevent secondary infections and complications.


Report on 72nd Constitutional Day at DIET-2021


