Gandhi Jayanti 2-10-2020

Brief summary of Abdul kalam

Early life and career

AvulPakirJainulabdeen Abdul Kalam was an Indian aerospace scientist who served as the [11th president of India](#) from 2002 to 2007. He was born and raised in [Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu](#) and studied [physics](#) and [aerospace engineering](#). He spent the next four decades as a scientist and science administrator, mainly at the [Defence Research and Development Organisation](#) (DRDO) and [Indian Space Research Organisation](#) (ISRO) and was intimately involved in India's civilian space program and military missile. He thus came to be known as the Missile Man of India for his work on the development of [ballistic missile](#) and [launch vehicle](#) technology. He also played a pivotal organizational, technical, and political role in India's [Pokhran-II](#) nuclear tests in 1998, the first since the [original nuclear test by India](#) in 1974.

President role , Awards

Kalam was [elected](#) as the 11th president of India in 2002 with the support of both the ruling [Bharatiya Janata Party](#) and the then-opposition [Indian National Congress](#). Widely referred to as the "People's President", he returned to his civilian life of education, writing and public service after a single term. He was a recipient of several prestigious awards, including the [Bharat Ratna](#), India's highest civilian honour.

Loss of Indian former president

While delivering a lecture at the [Indian Institute of Management Shillong](#), Kalam collapsed and died from an apparent [cardiac arrest](#) on 27 July 2015, aged 83. Thousands, including national-level dignitaries, attended the funeral ceremony held in his hometown of [Rameswaram](#), where he was buried with [full state honors](#)

This day is an opportunity to reaffirm the importance of

human rights in re-building the world we want, the need for global solidarity as well as our interconnectedness and shared humanity.
